You, and each of you, are hereby notified that the above-named Garnishee is attached by virtue of a Writ of Execution issued by the above-entitled Court in the above-entitled cause, and said Garnishee is hereby notified not to pay any monies due to said Defendant, and to retain possession of all property of said Defendant now or hereafter in its control or custody except as provided below in compliance with the Federal Wage Garnishment Law:

The garnishment restrictions of Title III of the Consumer Credit Protection Act (15 U.S.C. §1673) provide that no Court of the United States or of any state may make, execute, or enforce any order or process which provides for the garnishment of the aggregate disposable earnings of any individual for any workweek in an amount which is in excess of the lesser of the following restrictions:

1. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the individual's disposable earnings for the workweek, or
2. The amount by which his disposable earnings for that week exceed 30 times the minimum wage under §6 (a) (1) of the Fair Labor Standards

Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. §206 (a) (1), which is presently \$_____ an hour.

The restrictions do not apply in the case of:

1. Court orders for the support of any person,
2. Court orders under Chapter XIII of the Bankruptcy Act, and
3. Any debt due for any State or Federal tax.

"Disposable earnings" is compensation paid or payable for personal services less any amounts required to be withheld by law.

The law also prohibits any employer from discharging any employee because his earnings have been subjected to garnishment for any one indebtedness. The term "one indebtedness" refers to a "single garnishment proceedings," regardless of the number of levies made or creditors seeking satisfaction. Whoever discharges an employee in violation of the provisions of this law may be prosecuted criminally, and fined up to \$1,000.00 or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.

You are hereby further required to answer the questions provided by statute as hereinafter ^{***}set forth or, in default thereof, you are hereby further required to appear at the said Court on the 2nd day of November, 19 83, at 3:00 P. M., of said day to answer such Interrogatories as may be propounded or be liable to pay the entire judgment which the United States of America now has or may have against the said Defendant.

The above-named Defendant will hereby take notice of said garnishment and of service of notice thereof upon the said garnishee above-named and of the date of the return thereof in said Court, at which time and place said Defendant may appear and defend.
