The issues of this proceeding having been duly considered by the Honorable William L. Edmonds, United States Bankruptcy Judge, and a decision having been reached without trial or hearing,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

that Plaintiffs recover from the defendant Roger Dean Peters the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00); and that said judgment is excepted from discharge in bankruptcy pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(4). No execution shall issue pursuant to this judgment, however, until after November 1, 1988.

THE COURT FURTHER ORDERS that said judgment shall not accrue interest until November 1, 1988 at which time interest shall accrue at the statutory rate. The court costs of these proceedings are hereby taxed against defendant Roger Dean Peters.

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED that all proceedings as they pertain to defendant Kaye Evelyn Peters are hereby dismissed.

the Defendant ROGER DEAN PETERS is presently indebted to the


Plaintiffs in the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).




IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all proceedings as they pertain to Defendant KAY EVELYN PETERS are hereby dismissed.




