ORDER APPROVING TRUSTEE'S FINAL REPORT AND ACCOUNTING;
CLAIMS REPORT AND ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES APPLIED FOR

The matter before the court is the trustee's final report and accounting, claims report, and administrative expense application.

Notice was given to all creditors of the trustee's final report and accounting, claims report and administrative expense application by service on February 22, 1989.

On March 24, 1989, creditor Willow Tree Investments, Inc. filed an objection to the trustee's final report as to the amount of legal fees for David M. Nelsen as attorney for the trustee.

Hearing was scheduled on the final report and accounting, claims report, and administrative expense application for May 9, 1989. An order was entered on May 10, 1989 requiring attorney David Nelsen to amend his itemization for fees. Shortly thereafter, on May 15, 1989, Willow Tree Investments, Inc. withdrew its objection to the trustee's final report on the condition that the trustee's attorney's fee be reduced to \$4,950.00. This was in accordance with a telephone call to the court from attorney Nelsen and David L. Davitt as attorney for Willow Tree Investments, Inc. Nelsen agrees with the reduction and asks that the final report and accounting, claims report and administrative expense request be

approved.


The court, having examined the court file,

IT IS ORDERED that the trustee's final report and accounting is approved as described in the court notice of February 22, 1989; that the trustee shall make his distribution in accordance thereto including the payment of court costs, the payment of trustee's fees, and distribution to creditors.
