ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND JUDGMENT


The matter before the Court is the Motion by Defendant Bernard Sadler to Amend the Judgment entered in this adversary proceeding on August 6, 1986. Notice of this Motion was entered on August 19, 1986 setting a bar date of September 8, 1986 for filing objections. No objections were filed.

The Memorandum and Order for Judgment entered August 6, 1986 is amended to enlarge its Findings, finding Bernard Sadler to be a creditor of the Debtor, Gerald L. Pape, in Bankruptcy case No. 84-01005, and further that its Conclusions are amended to allow a claim by Bernard Sadler against the Debtor, Gerald L. Pape, in Bankruptcy No. 84-01005, in the amount of \$15,000 together with interest at the statutory rate from August 6, 1986 until paid.

The complaint of Victor V.
