

The Court is advised by the Attorneys by the respective parties that the parties have reached a settlement with regard to the claims raised by the Plaintiffs in the above adversary proceeding. The Plaintiffs have agreed to settlement and judgment in the amount of \$500 in addition to the court costs of bringing the above adversary action and the Defendants have agreed to the entry of a judgment for said amount. In consideration of the foregoing, the Plaintiffs have agreed not to pursue the dischargeability complaint alleged in their adversary proceeding and have agreed to accept said judgment in settlement of all of their claims which the Defendants agree is a nondischargeable obligation owing to the Plaintiffs to the extent of \$500 and court costs.

in the amount of \$500 in addition to the court costs of maintaining the above adversary proceeding.

It is further ordered that said judgment constitutes a nondischargeable obligation of the Defendants to the Plaintiffs and, further, that Plaintiffs' objection to discharge is dismissed.






