

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT

Franklin John Wilson, Defendant, and the United States of America, Plaintiff, by and through their undersigned attorneys hereby agree that the following shall constitute a Stipulated Settlement to the action to determine dischargeability of debts owed to the United States of America.

1. The Debtor owes to the United States of America acting through the Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) the principal sum of \$102,851.81 plus accrued interest for debts incurred prior to the filing of the bankruptcy petition.

2. The parties agree that \$42,320.56 of the total amount of the debt owed to FmHA is not a dischargeable debt of the the Defendant Franklin John Wilson.

3. The defendant consents to entry by this Court of judgment in favor of the United States of America for the full amount of the nondischargeable debt or \$42,320.56.

4. The United States of America agrees to accept payments totaling \$4,500, in full satisfaction of the amount owed by defendant to the FmHA.

5. The defendant agrees to pay the United States of America the total sum of \$4,500 in monthly installments of \$75 per month beginning November 1, 1987, for 5 years, or 60 months until the entire \$4,500 is paid.


6. The parties further agree that in the event the defendant defaults on any monthly payment as set forth in paragraph 5 above, that the United States of America shall be entitled to collect from the defendant the full amount of the judgment as entered by this court, unless otherwise agreed in writing between the defendant and the United States Attorney.

7. The parties further agree that upon completion by the defendant of the payments totaling \$4,500, the United States of America shall release the judgment entered by this Court and shall consider the entire debt paid in full.

8. The parties agree that Defendant Franklin John Wilson shall receive a discharge of the remaining debt due to the FmHA, except as set out in this stipulation.


