This matter comes before the Court and the Court being fully advised in the premises and being advised that the parties have agreed upon a settlement of this cause.

It is herewith ordered as follows:

1. Judgment shall enter against Lonnie VanDamme and Frances VanDamme, individually and severally, and in favor of the Plaintiff, C. R. Square D Credit Union, for the amount of \$4,000.00 plus interest at 11.5% per annum. Said judgment is to be made in weekly installments beginning November 1, 1987 in the amount of \$30.00 per week. The Defendant, Frances VanDamme, shall permit this amount to be deducted from her paycheck and she shall execute all documents with her employer necessary to permit this deduction.


2. In the event that all payments are made as provided herein, the Plaintiff, C. R. Square D Credit Union, may not institute other collection proceedings; however, in the event that payments are not made as required, then C. R. Square D Credit Union may institute appropriate proceedings to collect said judgment.

3. Upon the payments in full of this judgment, the Plaintiff, C. R. Square D Credit Union, will satisfy in full this judgment, and will execute all documents appropriate thereto.


4. That the Defendants will execute any and all documents necessary to confirm or reconfirm the Plaintiff's security interest in the AMC Spirit and Harley Davidson motorcycle which belong to Lonnie and Frances VanDamme subject to C. R. Square D Credit Union Lien.

5. That the Defendants will forthwith make available to be picked up by the Plaintiff, C. R. Square D Credit Union, the 1985 Honda Spree moped; 1977 Mercury Monarch, and the 1978 GMC Gaballero.
