This proceeding having come on for trial or hearing before the court, the Honorable William L. Edmonds, United States Bankruptcy Judge, presiding, and the issues having been duly tried or heard and a decision having been rendered,

The issues of this proceeding having been duly considered by the Honorable William L. Edmonds, United States Bankruptcy Judge, and a decision having been reached without trial or hearing,

### IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

that Defendant, Higher Education Assistance Foundation, a nonprofit Minnesota corporation (the "Foundation"), recover from Plaintiff, Donna S. Brown, the sum of \$10,303.22, this being the principal balance plus accrued interest on the student loans as of March 9, 1988. Interest shall accrue at the rate of 9% per annum.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff may pay the judgment in monthly installments as follows: \$70.00 for a two-year period beginning September 1, 1988; then \$80.00 each month for the following one-year period; then \$100.00 each month for the following one-year period; then \$120.00 each month for the following two-year period; and lastly, \$224.89 each month for the remaining four-year period. This debt must be paid in full by September 1, 1998.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that if the Plaintiff is late in making any payment for more than fifteen (15) days, the Foundation shall be free to pursue any and all lawful collection actions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Foundation shall waive any attorney's fees that it has incurred up until the date that this Judgment is entered.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Foundation shall waive the accrued interest from March 20, 1988, to September 1, 1988.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that BARBARA A. EVERLY Vol. II Page 109

Plaintiff's adversary proceeding shall be and hereby is dismissed with prejudice and that the Foundation's Counterclaim shall be and hereby is dismissed.

NOW on this 17 day of January, 1989, this matter comes before the Court on the parties' Stipulation for Entry of Judgment and Installment Payment Order. Having reviewed the same and being fully advised, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendant, Higher Education Assistance Foundation, a nonprofit Minnesota corporation (the "Foundation"), recover from Plaintiff, Donna S. Brown, the sum of \$10,303.22, this being the principal balance plus accrued interest on the student loans as of March 19, 1988. Interest shall accrue at the rate of 9% per annum.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff may pay the judgment in monthly installments as follows: \$70.00 for a two-year period beginning September 1, 1988; then \$80.00 each month for the following one-year period; then \$100.00 each month for the following one-year period; then \$120.00 each month for the following two-year


period; and lastly, \$224.89 each month for the remaining four-year period. This debt must be paid in full by September 1, 1998.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that if the Plaintiff is late in making any payment for more than fifteen (15) days, the Foundation shall be free to pursue any and all lawful collection actions.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Foundation shall waive any attorney's fees that it has incurred up until the date that this Judgment is entered.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Foundation shall waive the accrued interest from March 20, 1988, to September 1, 1988.

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff's adversary proceeding shall be and hereby is dismissed with prejudice and that the Foundation's Counterclaim shall be and hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
