COMES NOW the Plaintiff, Teamsters Local 238 Credit Union, and the Defendant, Robert James Raymer, and hereby respectfully state as follows:

1) That the Plaintiff filed a Complaint Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523 on or about December 20, 1988.

2) That the Plaintiff and the Defendant have entered into a settlement agreement, subject to Court approval, the terms of which are as follows:

- A) The Defendant, Robert James Raymer, agrees to pay the Plaintiff the sum of \$700.00 plus Court costs.
- B) The \$700.00 settlement plus Court costs would be amortized over a term of six months measured from March 1, 1989 with the first payment due on April 1, 1989. The \$700.00 payment plus Court costs would both bear interest at the rate of 15% per annum which is the normal used vehicle consumer loan rate of the Teamsters Local 238 Credit Union as of March 1, 1989.
- C) The amounts to be paid by the Defendant to the Plaintiff pursuant to this paragraph will

be entered as a judgment against the Defendant although the Plaintiff would agree to withhold execution upon the same subject to timely payments of principal and interest as are described herein above.

3) That the Plaintiff and the Defendant would request that the Court enter an Order approving of the Stipulation described herein and direct the Clerk to enter of record a judgment against Robert James Raymer in the amount of \$700.00 plus Court costs pursuant to the terms of this Stipulation.
