STIPULATION OF NONDISCHARGEABILITY



1. That the above-named debtor is indebted to the above-named creditor in the amount of \$525.00.


2. Said debt is nondischargeable, and in any action brought to determine the dischargeability of such debt the above-named debtor would have no defense.
