If such property is insufficient to satisfy the aforementioned amounts due from the defendant, Patrick Harrison, you are further commanded to subject to execution sale sufficient of the defendant's other nonexempt personal property situated in your district as may be necessary to satisfy the remaining balance, and if such personal property is insufficient, then you are commanded to satisfy any final balance by a levy on and sale of sufficient of the defendant's remaining nonexempt real property situated within your district.

You are further commanded to return this writ with an endorsement thereon showing the manner of your compliance with its terms, together with the proceeds from the execution sale or sales, by the 28th day of March, 1991.
