NOW ON this 16th day of May, 1991, this matter comes before the Court upon the Trustee's Notice and Report of Sale of Property filed on August 20, 1990. The Trustee proposed to sell on private sale all of debtor's rights, titles, and interests in the real estate located in Westfield, Iowa, legally described as:

The South One Hundred Feet (S 100') of Lot Twelve (12), in Block Nineteen (19), in the City of Westfield, Plymouth County, Iowa.

Said sale subject to all liens and taxes of record, to Marjorie J. Schierling for the sum of \$1,000.00.

The Court finds that notice of the Trustee's Notice and Report of Sale of Property was served upon all creditors and parties-in-interest as required by Bankruptcy Code and Rules as shown in certificate of service on file.

Further, the Court finds that the notice required that any objections to Trustee's Notice and Report of Sale of Property were to be filed with the Clerk of this Bankruptcy Court within 20 days (35 days if government agency) from the March 29, 1991, service date, with a copy of the same being forwarded to the Trustee, U.S. Trustee, and Debtors' attorney, and that barring any objections, parties were

notified that an Order would be entered approving said sale. Upon review of the file, the Court finds that there has been no timely-filed objections to the Trustee's Notice and Report of Sale of Property and further that granting said Notice and Report of Sale of Property would be in the best interest of the estate and said Notice and Report of Sale of Property should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Trustee's Notice and Report of Sale of Property filed on August 20, 1990, is approved, and the Trustee is further authorized to execute the necessary bill of sale to complete the sale transaction.
