NOW ON this 21st day of February, 1992, the above matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff's Application for Default, and the Court having reviewed the file, FINDS:


1. That Defendant was served with the Summons and Complaint on December 26, 1991, as evidenced by the Certificate of Service.
