AND NOW, this 28th day of July, 1992, the Stipulation entered into between the parties and signed on the 23rd day of June, 1992, comes before the Court.

THE COURT FINDS that it has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter and finds that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 USC Subsection 157(b)(2).

THAT THE PARTIES HAVE ENTERED into a Stipulation resolving all issues of this adversary proceeding and the Court therefore enters judgment as follows:

A. David John Boisen's The discharge of the debt to the Midwest Community Credit Union is excepted from discharge under 523(a)(1) ~~hereby revoked pursuant to Section 727(d)(1)~~ of the Bankruptcy Code.

B. Judgment is hereby entered against the Defendant in the principle amount of \$1,009.62 with interest from October 10, 1991, at 16 1/2 percent and the costs of this action.

C. Said judgment is payable in installments of \$68.80 per month including interest beginning the 25th day of ~~June~~^{September}, 1992, and due on or before the same day of each month thereafter is paid in full including interest on the unpaid balance at the rate shown above.

D. In the event that the Defendant fails to make any installment on the date due and fail to cure said default after twenty (20) days notice to him in writing, the judgment shall, upon the filing of an affidavit setting out the relevant facts, accelerate and become payable in full.


