Defendant shall provide such information to the United States Attorney, Financial Litigation Unit, P.O. Box 74950, Cedar Rapids, IA 52407-4950.

6. The defendant shall provide the United States with current, accurate evidence of his assets, income and expenditures (including, but not limited to, copies of prepared Federal income tax returns) within fifteen (15) days of the date of a request for such evidence by the United States Attorney.


