ORDER AND JUDGMENT


The matter before the Court is a complaint to determine dischargeability (cattle) debt filed by the Plaintiff Bank on November 9, 1993. The complaint alleged that the debt in the approximate original amount of \$3,587 should be declared non-dischargeable by operation of 11 U.S.C. §523 (a)(6).

Pursuant to stipulation and consent between the parties, THE COURT HEREBY FINDS, ORDERS, AND DECREES that a judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff Maquoketa State Bank and against Defendant Terence Reuter and Defendant Bonnie Reuter, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$2,000.00, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum from November 9, 1993, the date of filing the adversary complaint, until paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECREED that the judgment entered herein in favor of Maquoketa State Bank and against Terence Reuter and Bonnie Reuter, jointly and severally, is non-dischargeable by operation of 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(6), as prayed for by the Plaintiff in its complaint.


