This matter came on for scheduling conference on January 20, 1995. Appearing on behalf of plaintiff Tonya J. Thul was attorney James A. Trannel. Appearing on behalf of intervener Iowa College Student Aid Commission (ICSAC) was James S. Wisby, Assistant Attorney General.

The court has been informed of subsequent settlement discussions between the parties. Counsel for plaintiff, after

conferring with counsel for intervener ICSAC, accordingly, now requests permission to dismiss plaintiff's Complaint. Counsel for intervener ICSAC has no objection to the dismissal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Complaint herein of plaintiff Tonya J. Thul is dismissed as to intervener ICSAC.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment in favor intervener ICSAC be entered against plaintiff Tonya J. Thul in the negotiated sum of \$2,627.00, without interest or collection costs. No execution shall issue upon this judgment during the period which the plaintiff faithfully pays directly to the ICSAC at 201 Jewett Building, 914 Grand Ave., Des Moines, Iowa, 50309, the sum of \$43.00 per month, commencing on the fifteenth day of the first full month after date of entry of this Order, (10 day grace period), and continuing thereafter on the fifteenth day of each month until the entire negotiated sum has been paid in full. There shall be a late payment penalty of \$5.00. Proof of default by the plaintiff shall be made by the filing of an affidavit by the intervener herein as to the defaults of the plaintiff, specifying them, and upon the filing of such an affidavit of default, execution may issue at any time, without further notice, upon the request of the intervener.






