NOW, on this 22 day of August, 1995 this matter comes on before the Court, the Plaintiff appearing by its attorney, Gregory W. Peterson, and Defendant, appearing by his attorney, James A. O'Brien, and the Court, after reviewing the file and being fully advised in the premises finds:

1. That the parties have agreed that a judgment is to be entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, Timothy J. Chesterman, in the amount of \$7412.49 together with costs.

2. That Defendant has agreed to pay Plaintiff \$50.00 per month commencing on September 1, 1995 and continuing each and every month thereafter. 3. That so long as the payments outlined in the preceding paragraph are made by the Defendant, Plaintiff will forego any and all other collection activity.

4. That this Adversary proceeding should be resolved with the entry of the Judgment herein.


