That the debt due and owing to the Plaintiff Norwest Bank Iowa, N.A., is hereby preserved, and held non-dischargeable under 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(2)(A).

If the Defendant misses a payment, or fails to submit his payments in a timely manner, the Plaintiff shall be allowed to execute upon the entire remaining judgment balance.




