ORDER REVOKING DISCHARGE
UNDER 11 U.S.C. 727(d)(1)

The Trustee moved to revoke the Debtor's discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 727(d)(1), alleging the Debtor had concealed the transfer of a Harley Davidson motorcycle, with a value of approximately \$12,600.00 at the time of the transfer. The Debtor was discharged on August 1, 1996 and the Trustee did not learn of the transfer until after that date.

Proof of service is on file showing service on the Debtor on September 10, 1996. No answer or appearance has been filed.

The Court now finds the Motion for Default Judgment should be granted. The above described transfer is a fraudulent transfer not disclosed in the Debtor's schedules and is sufficient ground to revoke the previously granted discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 727(d)(1). Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED the general discharge granted the Debtor, James Paulsen, is now revoked. The Debtor is further ordered to pay the total court costs of this adversary action in the amount of \$ 120.00. Judgment shall enter accordingly.
