) ORDER REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF
) COMPENSATION - FORM B-280

In reviewing 11 U.S.C. § 110 (h)(1), and the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Rule 2016, the Court finds:

1. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2016, bankruptcy petition preparers are required to submit additional information over their signature under penalty of perjury. The appropriate form is known as “Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer”.
2. The “Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer” is required to be filed by the preparer, “within 10 days after the date of the filing of a petition.” 11 U.S.C. § 110(h)(1).
3. The information required to be divulged by the petition preparer is satisfied by completion of the “Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer” (Form B-280). Satisfactory completion of the form requires that:
 - a. It shall be signed by the individual petition preparer and not under any group or organizational name.
 - b. It shall contain the social security number of the individual petition preparer in the place designated.

- c. The individual preparer shall date the form on the date that it is signed by the individual petition preparer.
 - d. The petition preparer shall print the individual petition preparer's name and address in the place designated on the form.
4. The "Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer" (Form B-280) is contained and available on the public website for the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Iowa, www.ianb.uscourts.gov, under the category, "Forms."


THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, a "Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer" (Form B-280) shall be submitted in every case prepared by petition preparers within the Northern District of Iowa and presented to this Court.

This order shall take effect on January 15, 2005.
