Pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §956, in connection with cases and proceedings commenced under the Bankruptcy Code, in connection with cases pending or reopened under the Bankruptcy Code, and pursuant to this Court's Local Rule 5075-1(e) in which this court may delegate authority to execute certain orders in a bankruptcy proceeding to the Bankruptcy Clerk, on August 1, 1990, this Court entered Administrative Order 101, thereby authorizing the Bankruptcy Clerk to sign and enter specific orders which are deemed to be of ministerial nature. On January 7, 2005, this Court erroneously entered Standing Order No. 5, which amended Administrative Order 101 to include the delegation of authority to the Bankruptcy Clerk to sign "Orders authorizing disbursement of funds from the court's registry accounts upon proper application of a party in interest." The amendment captured within Administrative Order No. 5 is deemed improper as the Judiciary's Guide to Policies and Procedures, Chapter 7, Part D, 2.1.1. clearly states: "Courts are also authorized to disburse registry funds in accordance with 28 U.S.C. 2042. However, unlike appropriated funds, registry funds may only be disbursed by court order directing the clerk to pay out the funds."

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Standing Order No. 5 is vacated and of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all authorities and delegations as granted in Administrative Order 101 shall remain in full force and effect.


