On December 1, 2009, the revised Local Rules of Court for the U. S. Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of Iowa (hereafter Local Rules) will go into effect. These Local Rules not only incorporate the updated time period calculations of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, also effective on December 1, 2009, but also incorporate the requirements and procedures proscribed in a number of this Court’s active Standing Orders. The enactment of the revised Local Rules on December 1, 2009, obviates the need for redundant Standing Orders to remain active.

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective December 1, 2009, the following Standing Orders are vacated, of no further force and effect, and the requirements established therein are incorporated into the Court’s revised Local Rules:

- Standing Order No. 08-06 - Disclosure/Corporate Ownership Statement Requirements
- Standing Order No. 09-04 - Video Monitoring and Recording of Courtroom Proceedings
