
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective IMMEDIATELY, that:

1. All petitions filed with schedules in the Northern District of Iowa, regardless of chapter, shall be prepared and submitted for filing including pages 1 and 2 of the Summary of Schedules/Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities (Official Form B6), attached hereto as Exhibit #1.
2. All subsequently filed original schedules filed in the Northern District of Iowa, regardless of chapter, shall be prepared and submitted for filing including pages 1 and 2 of the Summary of Schedules/Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities (Official Form B6), attached hereto as Exhibit #1.
3. All amended schedules filed in the Northern District of Iowa, regardless of chapter, shall be prepared and submitted for filing including pages 1 and 2 of the Summary of Schedules/Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities (Official Form B6), attached hereto as Exhibit #1.
4. All adversary complaints filed/adversary proceedings initiated in the Northern District of Iowa, shall be prepared and submitted for filing including the revised Adversary Cover Sheet (Director's Form B104), attached hereto as Exhibit #2.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that IANB Standing Order No.06-21 is hereby
